

THE NORMAL ZONE CONSIDERATION FOR PROMOTION RULES, 1982

Notification No. 11195-F

Dated the 22nd October, 1982

In exercise of the power conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor is pleased hereby to make the following rules:—

RULES

1. These rules may be called the Normal Zone of Consideration for Promotion Rules, 1982.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in any rules or procedure regulating the recruitment to any service or post under the State Government by promotion normal zone of consideration in respect of promotion to such service or post shall consist of such of the employees eligible for promotion to such service or post according to the rules or procedure regulating the recruitment thereto as occupy when arranged in descending order of the seniority, five times the number of vacancy or vacancies actually available for filling up by promotion at the time of considerations :

Provided that the Public Service Commission or any selecting authority or the appointing authority shall have the discretion to consider further cases of eligible officers in the event of non availability of the requisite number of suitable officers within the normal zone of consideration.

Note.—In cases where a group of posts/service having separate gradation lists are prescribed in the recruitment rules as feeder posts/service for promotion to another higher post/service the zone of consideration shall consist of five times the vacancies actually-available in the promotion post/service at the time of consideration in each group of feeder post/service, if available.

3. These rules shall take effect from the date of issue of this-notification.
